**705** EXITS TO SAFE & SECURE PERMANENT  
HOUSING

-  Through their diversion program, Family Promise of Greater Indy saved **32 families** from having to enter a shelter.
-  Gennesaret Free Clinics has already served as many individuals as they did in **all of 2021**.
-  At Coburn Place, adult survivors have engaged in **61 sessions** of financial literacy, life skills programming, and educational workshops.
-  **100%** of the youth at Indiana Youth Group have developed and effectively practiced home-care skills.
-  Family Promise of Hendricks County has already surpassed their goal to provide emergency shelter to **135 individuals** & 103 are already in permanent housing.
-  **89%** of clients participating in case management at Alternatives, Inc have exited to safe and secure homes.

# EVERYONE DESERVES A SAFE HOME

When we hear personal accounts from our grantees, it helps to open our eyes to the broad spectrum of reasons that cause homelessness and the barriers that exacerbate it. Stories like Janice's, a single mother of three children, who found herself without a safe home at no fault of her own. Running from a violent situation at home with nowhere to go, Janice sought help at Holy Family Shelter, a 2022 Foundation grantee, and within hours Holy Family had her and her children safe in emergency housing. The staff brought food, clothing, personal care items, cookware, and even asthma medicine for her middle child.

The following morning, Janice met with a Holy Family case manager who began an assessment in six core areas: health, housing, income, children's needs, legal, and education. Janice was already employed, so her main goals were to heal from her past trauma and obtain secure housing. During her stay, Holy Family Shelter provided Janice with counseling, trauma recovery, and life skills training. Janice was soon accepted into a rapid rehousing program, where she was finally able to move into her own apartment with her children.

Because of the transitional housing services supported by REALTOR® Foundation grants, Janice was given the resources necessary to find a stable place for her and her children to live. They could finally feel safe in their own home for the first time in years. Through this support, Janice was finally able to provide the life for her children that she had always dreamed of giving them.
